1949

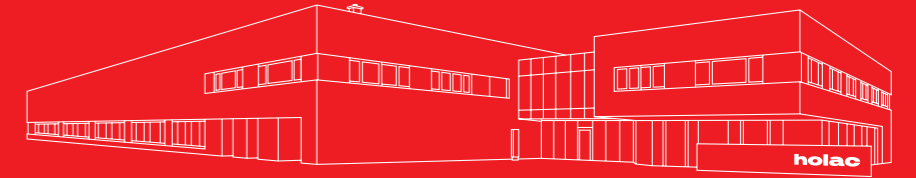


Demand for holac cutting machines is high. The first foreign agencies are established in Finland, Italy and the USA, and in the following decades, the international dealer network continues to grow.

1984

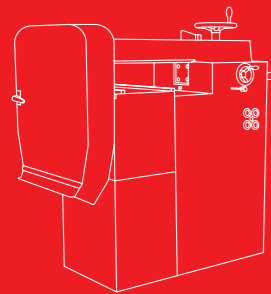


holac moves into its new company headquarters in Nattheim. The modern new building with spacious premises offers optimum working conditions for the then 80 employees.

1974

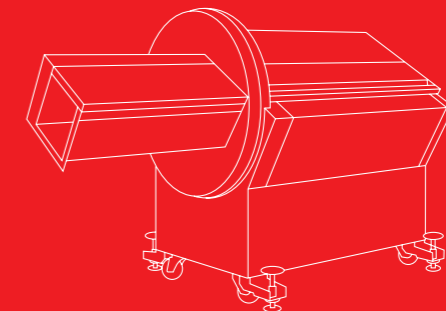
The second generation of the founding family takes over the management role: Ernst Holz junior and his wife Hannelore Holz are now at the helm of holac Maschinenbau GmbH.
